ITEMS FOR THE 1982 ANNUAL

He reminds members that logs must be submitted to him at The Shack, Baily, Dublin before the 31st October, if they are to be included in the 1982 Annual. Any logs submitted after that date will not be included in publication. This deadline is necessary to ensure publication by a reasonable date.

Members submitting logs or articles for "Dunns Ditties", are asked to do so in type script. Black and white photographs are always particularly welcome. Regrettably it is not possible to publish colour prints. Photographs in black and white should be supplied on a print size of approximately eight inches by six inches.

Logs for a competition should be in duplicate and consist of log in type-script, a track chart, plus a summary of distances covered to include such things as distance log, distance rhumb line, time at sea, time away and engine hours.

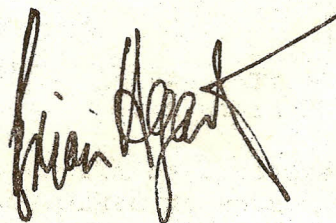
