Location : N E corner of Ria de Muros y Noia, 2.5nm SW of Noia.

You can contact me by telephone or email at Real Club Náutico, Portosin. I speak English & French. The club has a marina (Ch9) within the large fishing harbour and we especially welcome all foreign yachts. I can assist you with National Park Permits, Customs, Immigration and Police. All yacht services are available here including fuel and lift out. Technical experts are available and will call to the yard on request. We have a small workshop with tools available to you. Just five minutes walk will bring you to a modern medical centre that accepts EHI cards.

Visitors are very welcome to use ALL the club facilities including our restaurant and bar with terrace and large balcony that enjoy magnificent views down the ria to the ocean. We have our own on site laundry and especially large shower and changing rooms. In recent times the village has been greatly improved with many restaurants and bars, a large supermarket, bank, pharmacy, and well stocked hardware store with Camping Gas. Immediately beside the club is a pretty beach with safe swimming.

Portosin is the nearest yacht marina to Santiago de Compostela (30mins) and it's international airport (45 mins). We can arrange transfers with English speaking driver, or car-hire, or local buses, and the club have bicycles for local use.

The ria is surrounded by many attractions, and especially a short trip is recommended to see the ancient fort at Castro de Baroña. The nearby town of Noia has a large medieval quarter with many interesting buildings a summer festival and good shopping. Across on the west side of the ria is the town of Muros with a marina and attractive seafront. The small port of Freixo is famous for it's old wooden boat building industry.

Many ICC members may remember me from the 2017 Rally, which I enjoyed organising with help from Peter Haden. You will usually find me in the club office waiting to help you.
